

MILLENNIUM RAFFLE WINNER SENDS LETTER ...


Dot (Weida) McGarry '46 was the December \$100 winner and then was the lucky winner of the final \$1,000 drawing. She sent the following note of thanks:

NAMES IN THE NEWS ...

Martha (Blackmer) Carey '44 celebrated her 75th birthday by para-sailing 800 feet over the ocean while visiting her nephew in Hawaii.

Don Reynolds celebrated his 90th birthday in January with family and friends. Reynolds is believed to be our oldest alumni, who attended Lehman as a student in 1926 when Lehman was a junior high prior to becoming a high school. He then went to McKinley High School to be a part of the class of 1929.

Gregg Schorsten '65 was recently inducted into the Ex-Newsboys' Hall of Fame.

Marcia (Albert) Schonberg from the class of 1964 was recently recognized in *The Repository* for her book *B is for Buckeye*. The alphabet style book is for children but each letter is geared toward Ohio such as "c" is for the red carnation that William McKinley always wore and Alliance is known as the Carnation City. The letter "v" for vacuum tells how the Hoover sweeper came into existence.

This is the third book for Schonberg and all are Ohio related. The review stated "it is a book that will make a native Ohioan's heart swell with pride."

Brady Steineck, grandson of Jean (Miller) and Harry Steineck '48 and a 2000 Lehman Alumni scholarship recipient, received a well deserved write up in *The Repository* for his baseball talents at the University of Akron. Brady is expected to make the team in his freshman year and still carries a 4.0 average in his studies.

Richard Morena '56 and his partner were recently written up in *The Repository* for their business, Environmental Chemical Corporation. Two years later they moved and have changed locations four additional times. They have 55 employees and did \$5 million in sales in 1999 and hope for \$7 million in 2001.

CANTON MEMORIAL FIELDHOUSE

December 5th, 1950, Lehman played the opening game before a crowd of 1,054 against Uhrichsville in the new Memorial Fieldhouse. Lehman won 31-29. That same night Jim Robinson was honored for 25 years of coaching. Booster Club President Karl Yant drove a new Oldsmobile onto the floor and gave the keys to Coach Robinson. Robinson cried in humility.

The largest crowd ever attending for a single game in the Fieldhouse was for a Lehman-McKinley game during the 1965-66 season.

The Fieldhouse was officially dedicated on November 24th, 1950, to "the young men and women from Canton schools who have honorably served their country in the armed services."

The Fieldhouse is about to undergo a renovation and would you believe they are going to make a section of the seats red and another section blue. They stated it is to show the difference between reserved and general admission seats – or is it really red for McKinley and blue for Timken ...
