LOOKING BACK

A board member was going through some treasures and found a *Repository* dated October 8, 1981. A little yellowed, but what caught her eye was the headline "MEMORY OF CANTON COACH HONORED BY HOUSE ACTION." It was reported that the Ohio House of Representatives passed unanimously a Resolution honoring the memory of Canton's long-time coach Jim Robinson who had died in September of that year. Part of the wording in the resolution sponsored by State Representative Charles "Red" Ash read: "James P. Robinson is proclaimed the father of the North-South All-Star football game and accompanying clinic ... he had a paramount concern for young people ... gave the best possible guidance for his players on and off the field ... he was a remarkable individual."

"We in the House voted for it out of respect for the man and his diligence as far as the youth of Ohio were concerned," stated Ash.

A lot of alumni will recall being coached by Robinson, but I can recall his comments at an assembly when he came to Lehman stating, "if you can't beat 'em, join 'em."

NEW SCHOOL PROGRESS

DOES IT AGAIN!


Students from the Lehman Middle School went to Columbus and came home with the championship trophy again.


