
SCHOLARSHIP DEADLINE REMINDER

May 1, 2006, is the deadline for submitting totally completed requests for the Alumni Association Scholarships to be awarded in July. If you have a direct descendant who is either completing high school and planning higher education or is already attending a technical college, college or university, and you were an Association member in 2005 and have paid your 2006 dues, if he or she has not already done so, have your descendant expediently send an application request to the Alumni Association at Post Office Box 7498, Canton, OH 44705-7498, complete with a stamped self-addressed envelope or download these from cantonlehman.com. We will be awarding 30 scholarships this year, so there are more opportunities than ever for your descendant to obtain a scholarship to assist in financing his or her higher education.

MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

Greetings, Fellow Alumni:

First, I am happy to announce that the Canton Lehman High School Alumni Association has been granted exemption from Federal income tax under section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The effective Date of Exemption is November 10, 2005. Contributions are deductible under section 170 of the code. Donors must have written substantiation from us for any charitable contribution of \$250 or more. It is the donor's responsibility to obtain written substantiation from this organization, but we are in the process of establishing procedures to automatically provide a written statement to anyone donating more than \$250. This should be in place before April.

As indicated in the article on the Polar Party, it was another very successful event. A special thanks to all of the Trustees for getting the items for the "Silent Auction" and in getting the large number of Alumni and friends to attend the event. Most gratifying was the high noise level at the function. It was hard to make announcements due to the "swapping of memories" by the attendees. It was a great night, and the scholarship fund was greatly enhanced.

During the next period the board will concentrate on one of the most important functions of this Association, processing of the scholarship requests and the selection and awarding of the scholarships. Due to the tremendously successful Polar Party and to the generous donations from Alumni Association members and friends, we have raised the number of scholarships to be awarded from 25 to 30 Scholarships each of \$500. Our scholarship committee, headed by Claudia Selby, will be evaluating the requests. Tim Elder maintains the books, making sure that all the forms have been completed correctly and that applicants fully qualify. Since this is the Association's most important task, we want to make sure that all the applications are correct and all of the necessary information is received. For example, school grades must come from the current school. This takes time, so if you know someone who would like to be considered for a scholarship and is a Lehman High School Alumnus or a direct descendant, they should request an application by writing the Lehman Alumni Association, Scholarship Committee, P.O. Box 7498, Canton, OH 44705-7498, enclosing a stamped self-addressed envelope. There is a requirement that the alumnus be a member for two

There is an area which has a number of photos. There is a Memoriam area where deaths are listed.


You may add additional information by contacting either Marilyn at 330-492-8820 or the Canton Lehman Alumni Association at our Post Office Box.
