Georgia Eshelman gave an enlightening talk and the evening was concluded with "cake" no less. What else would "cake eaters" serve!





Robert A. Rhodes '53 – is Master of Canton Council No. 35, Royal & Select Masons.


Harry Steineck '48 – made <u>The Repository</u> with a looking back feature from 1964 for water skiing at the once famous Meyers Lake.

We never could get her to give us a photo of herself, so many of the alumni will never recognize her if they pass her anywhere, but the active members know who she is and how much she has done over the past three years.


First, she offered to serve as president after being the secretary. She not only served the first year and a second year, but went back for one more year when no one else was willing to step forward.
