47 TO RECEIVE SCHOLARSHIPS AT 2009 SCHOLARSHIP DINNER

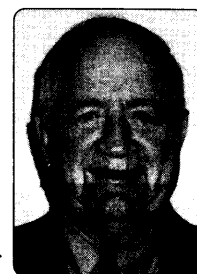

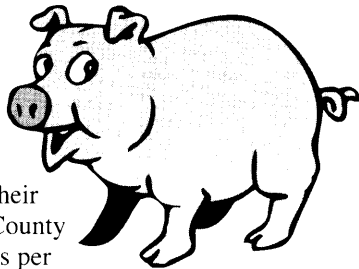
HILL GANG GOLF OUTING
