

NAMES IN THE NEWS

John Werren '55 was pictured on the cover of the June issue of *About Magazine* in conjunction with an article on 12 Things You Didn't Know about Stark (County) which recognized him as a noted local historian.

Carol Krider Vaughn '56 and Carl Lavin '42 have been named to the Board of Trustees of the Palace Theatre Association.

The late **Jed Taylor '54** was honored by the J. Babe Stearn Center during a ceremony on April 14 as one of seven basketball players in the Canton area who scored fifty or more points in one game.

Stark County Probate Judge Dixie Park, who serves as the installation officer for the Lehman High School Alumni Association officers and trustees each year, was honored by being inducted into the YMCA Stark County Women's Hall of Fame in recognition of her human service.

North Canton veterinarian Dr. Jennifer Jellison, owner of the For Paws Animal Hospital and a *Journal* advertiser, recently traveled to New York with two puppies up for adoption at the Stark County Humane Society to appear on "Live with Kelly" where she presented two segments on summer pet health care.

Lehman was featured in two Through the Century articles in the Canton Repository, both occurring 50 years ago. The first detailed a project of Lehman's student council as about 20 boys and their fathers painted the gymnasium using a grant of \$100 from the organization. The second noted that **Bob Neading '64** emerged as the hero in his first varsity appearance as his jump shot with two seconds to go propelled the Polar Bears to victory over Newark, 49-47.

Bob Kistler, a former teacher and coach at Lehman, was profiled in the *Repository*'s World War II: Then and Now series which recounted his service in the Pacific Theater as a cook and medic.

Lazer Tarzen who attended Lehman was profiled in the same series which described his service as a Radioman on a Destroyer escort in the Pacific during the war.

Longtime Lehman hangout Taggarts is on a roll. In addition to the specific Lehman associated activities published in this edition of the *Journal*, first it was the subject of a laudatory article in the *Repository* on its food and ice cream treats, and then was highlighted in an article headlined "Great Eats" by noted foodies Jane and Michael Stern in *Parade Magazine*, under Midwest at its Best, which stated "Travel down Interstate 77 to Canton, home of the Pro Football of Fame, for a visit to Taggarts, a circa 1920 sweet shop that makes ridiculously thick shakes."

Dr. Bruce Hensley and Richard Stewart, who are the principals involved in the planned conversion of the old Lehman building to a health care facility, were the recipients of the 2012 Hero Award from the Stark County Minority Health Coalition for their efforts in founding the Healing and Wellness Center to provide health care to uninsured and underinsured Canton residents.






