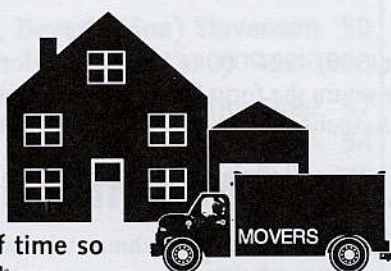

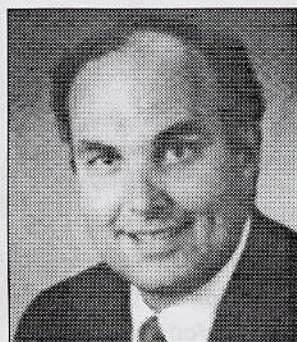

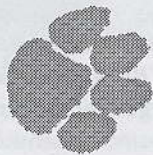
The first two winners were Martha (Baughman) Grant '38 of Boynton Beach, Florida, in July and Joe Helaney '57, in July.

TED WILLIAMS stated his dreams are to become a sports broadcaster and Broadcast Journalism is his course at Ohio State University. He also liked the food at the banquet.

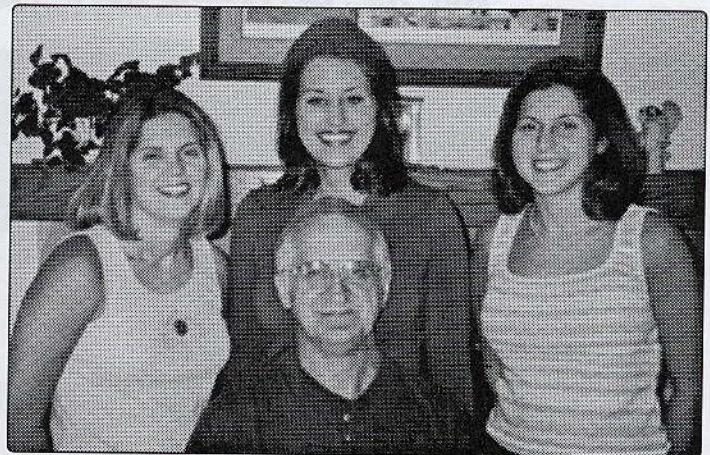
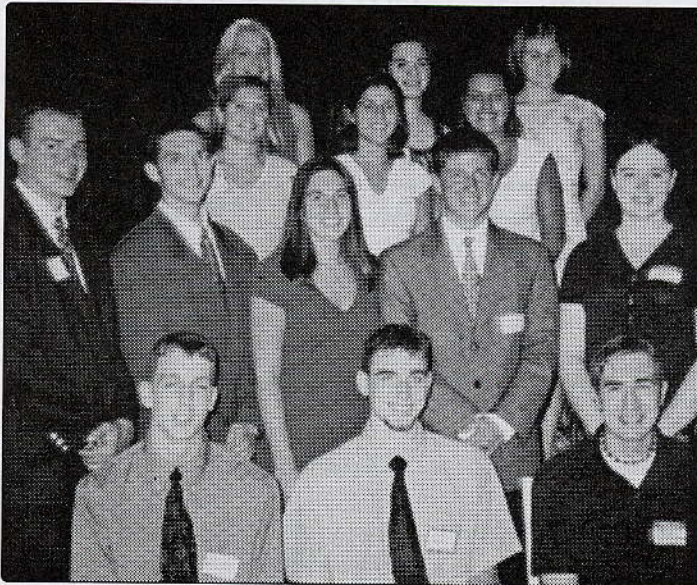


There has been discussion several time that we should give larger scholarships to fewer students, but the majority of the committee has recommended that we remain at \$500.
